MAKE YOUR OWN LANTERN

You will need:

Scissor (ask an adult to help)

Glue or tape

Coloured crayons or pens

String

Coloured tissue or film (optional)

Card (optional)

1. Copy the template (right) onto card if you have some.
2. Cut around the outside of the pattern (right).
3. Fold along the dotted lines. You can now cut out the inside shapes with scissors to create star and diamond windows.
4. Decorate with pens or crayons. You can stick coloured tissue paper or film over the star shaped windows.
5. Fold the lantern into a hexagonal tube and glue or tape the tabs along the side and base.
6. Pierce the black dots and thread through a string as a handle.
7. Join a lantern procession through Rotherhithe & Bermondsey on **Friday 29th November starting at 5pm**. You can claim a **free night light** to illuminate your lantern. You can also copy this pattern to make lots of lanterns!
